CAMPGROUND CANCELLATION POLICY

MRA campground rules and policy must be read prior to confirmation.

Reservations

Camping reservations require a credit card **payment in full** at the time of booking to reserve your sites. Camping reservations are confirmed when payment is received in full.

Refund

To receive a camping refund, Mountain & River Adventures (MRA) must receive a **written request**, fifteen days prior to your scheduled arrival date. Camping refunds are given, less a \$25 processing fee for the first camp site, plus \$5 per each additional site reserved. Refunds are not available if you choose not to fulfill your agreement, are asked to leave, do not make proper notification or fail to show up. Refunds will be issued within 30 days of receipt of qualified cancellation.

Fees

A **clean-up fee** of \$35/site will be charged to you if you leave your camp site(s) unclean (e.g. trash on ground or in fire ring). Please contain all garbage in your camp site, and when full, place bagged garbage in bins centrally located in campground. Garbage bags will be made available upon request; however this is your responsibility.

MRA campground has a **three (3) night minimum** on all **holiday weekends** and is \$54.00 per site, per night on Friday, Saturday, & Sunday with up to (6) people per site. There is a two (2) night camping minimum on all other weekends. Camp site prices are \$48.00 per site, per night; up to six (6) people per site. **If you are booking an activity with MRA you will receive a discount on each camp site booked.** All camping reservations require a credit card payment in full to reserve.

Special Event Usage (private parties)

MRA reserves the right to separately book our Bull Run Pavilion and/or Bud's Grove for private parties at any time. Once facility amenity is booked for a private party/special event, the area(s) will be available to other camper's once event has been cleaned up. We will notify campers of the time and date of a special event, so camper's can plan to use these areas before or after private events.

Take Care of It!

MRA encourages each of our camping guests to help preserve our pristine environment by creating less trash in the first place. When planning to visit the Sequoia National Forest, remember to pack items such as reusable/washable food containers and eating utensils, use cloth towels instead of paper, and bring reusable water bottles. Campers are encouraged to bring a "mess kit" (washable eating utensils) for each meal. Cans instead of glass beverage containers are also safer. These are just a few examples of how you can generate less trash, save room in our landfills and leave behind something precious for future generations. Thank you for respecting our forest.
